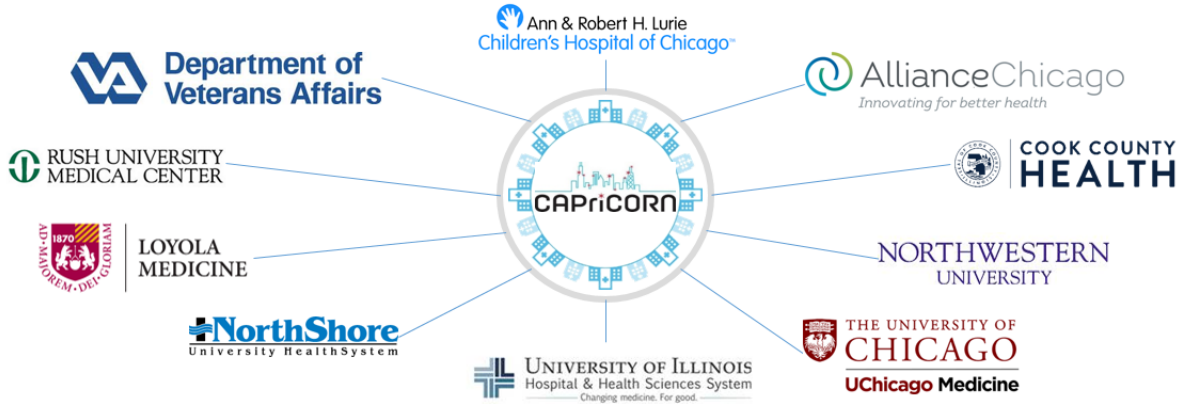


CAPRICORN, A PATIENT-CENTERED OUTCOMES AND RESEARCH NETWORK

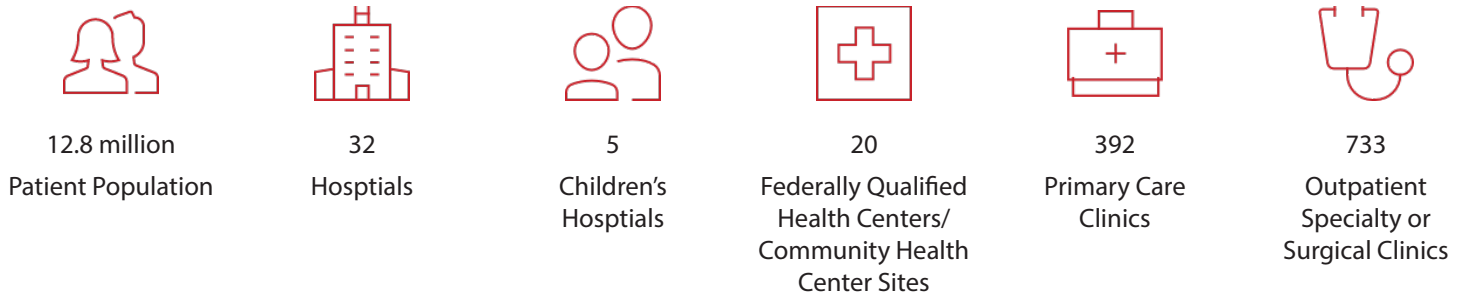

The network of data-sharing institutions is expanding in 2022.

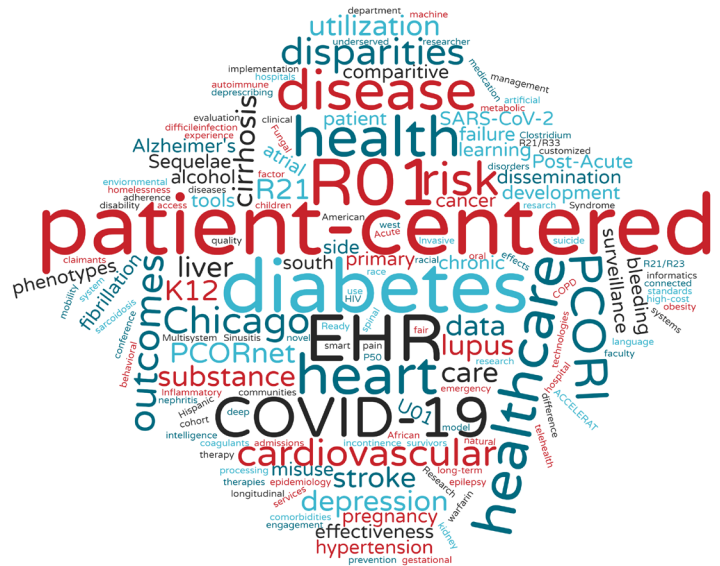
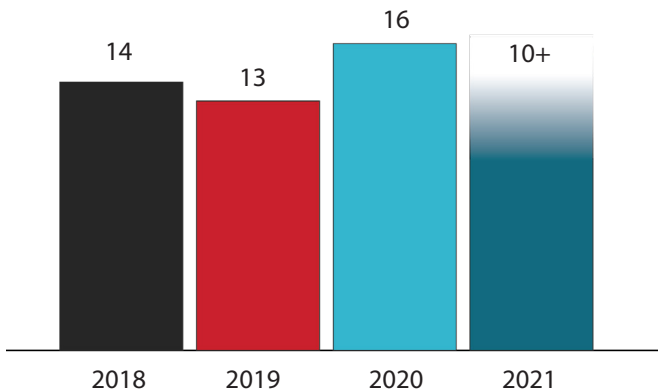
The network has continuously grown since its founding in 2013 and currently includes...

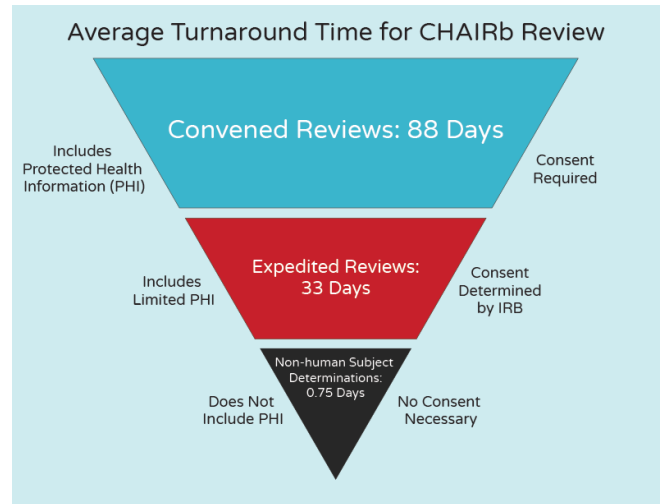

7 initial reviews, 26 convened IRB reviews, 236 amendment reviews, 48 continuing reviews, 3 prompt reports, 4 final reports

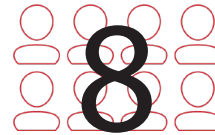


The Patient Community Advisory Committee (PCAC) guides leadership decisions and priority areas.

26 ACCELERAT scholar publications have been supported by CAPriCORN data and infrastructure.

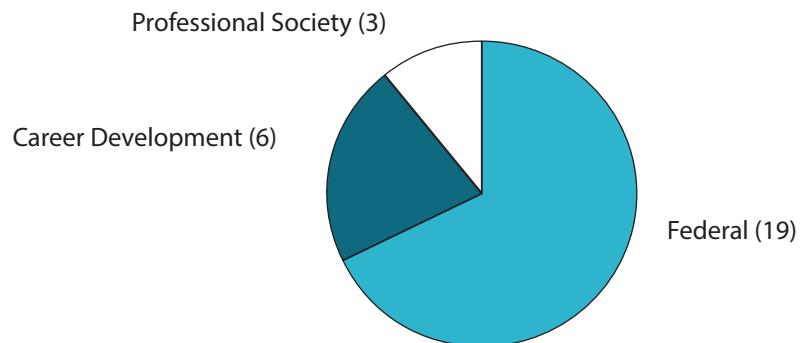
